# A short reflection on today's Gospel

Today's Gospel teaches us a fundamental Christian truth which gloriously liberates the soul but may strike fear in the timorous heart: death is a prerequisite of life. If there is no Good Friday, there is no Easter Sunday. Death of any kind is a subject from which most of us shy away. We know that we are mortal creatures, but we often live as though our time on earth is unlimited, as though we will live forever. We may know that there are aspects of our lives to which we must die if we are to thrive and prosper in the light of God and bear good fruit, but we procrastinate over and over, telling ourselves that we have plenty of time before letting those aspects fall into the earth and die.

In today's Gospel Jesus speaks to us in the knowledge that he is standing in the shadow of his forthcoming Passion and death. He is the grain of wheat which will fall on the ground and die in order to yield the rich harvest of humanity's salvation; in order to open the door to eternal life for all who believe in him. His death will call us to eternal life. Good Friday lights the way to Easter Sunday.

Jesus, as we stand in the light of your Passion and death may we have the courage to face and let fall to the ground to die those aspects of ourselves which prevent us from yielding good fruit.

In the light of our knowledge that final death calls us to eternal life, may we live our lives fully, gratefully and bravely, and may we develop and share with others the gifts of compassion and genuine kindness as we sojourn through our allotted span.
