

As a parish community we look forward to the ordination of Deacon Shaun Doherty to the Priesthood here at Saint Eugene's Cathedral on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at 3.00pm. He will be celebrating his first Mass at Saint Columb's Church, Chapel Road, Waterside, on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 7.30pm. Everyone is welcome. *We ask you Lord Jesus, to fill Shaun with the fire of your love, that his ministry may reveal your presence in the Church.*

**A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 10:26-33**

Today's Gospel witnesses Jesus making it clear to his followers that their mission to spread the Good News will not be easy: Like him they will meet with opposition. Like him they will be reviled and persecuted. But Jesus, knowing the stultifying, paralysing effects of fear, urges them not to be afraid. They are precious in the eyes of God who cares lovingly for all of His creation: not a sparrow falls to the ground unnoticed by God; not a hair on a human head remains uncounted by Him. In the face of trials and tribulations God will stand with those who uphold truth.

It is clear that Jesus is encouraging his followers to see the big picture rather than imprison themselves within the little picture. The death of the body isn't a calamity to be dreaded. It is not an ending. It is a transformation which opens the gates of eternal life to the faithful, to those who know that life is not about them; life is about God. It is always about God.

Help us, Jesus, to withstand the cynicism and arrogance of our modern world and to hold fast to our belief in a loving God, our God, who knows every hair on our heads, and in whose eyes we are infinitely precious. Help us to see the big picture always and to see the death of the body, not as an ending, but as a beautiful transformational experience which welcomes us into eternal life. Help us to know that Jesus will stand with us in our struggles in this life if we stand by Jesus and live out his truth, his ministry of love.

**The Annual Service of Intercession for the Dead** takes place in the City Cemetery this afternoon at **3.00 pm**. Please be in position at 2.30 pm. Families are asked to bring their own holy water to the Cemetery for the blessing of the graves. At the appropriate time Bishop McKeown will ask a representative of each family to sprinkle their family grave (and neighbouring grave if there is no-one present). There will be no holy water in the Cemetery.

**The cemetery will be closed from 12 noon to facilitate preparations for the service. Only vehicles which have already been allocated a designated parking space on site can access the cemetery after this time, and these vehicles must be in place before 2.00pm.** Vehicle access to the cemetery will be via the Lone Moor Road Gate only. Accessible parking spaces will be available for Blue Badge Holders at St Mary's Church, St Cecilia's College and Celtic Park. Access to these sites will only be given to vehicles that display a Disability Blue Badge Permit.

We encourage those attending to arrive in good time, and to adhere to the advice of the stewards. We would greatly appreciate cooperation with staff to ensure everyone can have safe and easy access to this time of prayer.
