

A short Gospel reflection Matthew 2:1-12

Today's Gospel opens with Jesus on the mountain, teaching not from power, but from compassion. The Beatitudes turn the world upside down: the poor, the meek, the merciful, and the persecuted are called blessed. Jesus is not romanticising suffering; He is revealing where God already dwells. In a world that prizes success, strength, and recognition, Christ points us to a deeper happiness rooted in trust, humility, and love.

These words invite us to examine our own hearts. Do we seek comfort at any cost, or are we willing to hunger for righteousness? Do we avoid sorrow, or allow it to soften us into mercy? The Beatitudes are not a checklist, but a portrait of Christ Himself—and a path of discipleship. When we choose to live this way, even quietly and imperfectly, we discover that true joy is not found in having more, but in belonging more fully to God.

Prayer to St Brigid: Saint Brigid, beloved servant of Christ, you showed us how to love the poor, to welcome the stranger, and to see God's presence in everyday life.

Teach us generosity of heart, gentleness in strength, and faith that burns like a steady flame. May our homes be places of peace, our hands ready to serve, and our lives a blessing to others. Saint Brigid, pray for us.

Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood: You call blessed those who are meek, merciful, and pure of heart—raise up from our midst men who will live these Beatitudes as diocesan priests. May their lives proclaim Your Kingdom, bringing comfort, justice, and peace to the people You entrust to their care.
