A short Gospel reflection Luke 12: 13-21

"A Man's life is not made secure by what he owns, even when he has more than he needs." Today's Gospel witnesses Jesus' warning of the folly of looking only inwards to one's own interest instead of 'making himself rich in the sight of God.' He warns against greed for 'bigger barns' in our mistaken notion that the more we have, the safer and secure we'll be. The parable of The Rich Fool through which he illustrates this is a powerful invitation for us to look outwards instead of inwards and thus enter into communion with God, communion with others, communion with creation. The Rich Fool is smug, self-obsessed, inordinately pleased with himself and his 'bigger barns,' unaware that death will claim him that very night; unaware that, in his final moments, the truth will hit him forcibly: the truth that God is not interested in his 'bigger barns,' but will ask only, "How much love have you poured into others during your lifetime? How much love have you been open to receiving from others?"
