

### A short Gospel reflection Matthew 5:13-16

In today's Gospel, Jesus names our identity before He gives us a task: you are the salt of the earth, you are the light of the world. Salt doesn't exist for itself—it preserves, brings out flavour, and quietly transforms what it touches. Light doesn't argue or explain; it simply shines and makes things visible. Jesus is reminding us that discipleship isn't mainly about standing out, but about being faithful right where we are, letting God work through ordinary lives.

This Gospel also carries a gentle but honest challenge. Salt can lose its taste, and light can be hidden or covered up. When we live our faith half-heartedly, or keep it private out of fear, comfort, or a desire not to be noticed, the world misses something essential. Our faith was never meant to be locked away or lived only in safe spaces; it is meant to shape how we speak, how we act, and how we treat others each day. When our words and actions flow from prayer, humility, and love, they become signs that point beyond us. The goal is not to draw attention to ourselves, but—just as Jesus says—to let our light shine so that others may see goodness, hope, and mercy at work, and through that, give glory to the Father.

**Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood:** You call servants to be salt and light for Your people. Raise up generous hearts for the diocesan priesthood, and give them courage to follow You with joy.
