A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 1:18-24

Scripture, in general, tells us little about Joseph, Mary's betrothed. However, careful reading of today's Gospel reveals Joseph to us as an extraordinarily gifted man of faith and truth, well-chosen by God to be the foster father of Jesus, His only Son.

Joseph knew the law. He knew that the law entitled him to cast off Mary as soon as he realised that she was carrying a child that was not his. It is extraordinary to learn that Joseph's concern was not for the law or his own feelings; his concern was for Mary; his unerring instinct for the truth of his young wife is what lies behind his decision to overlook the law, disobey the law, in fact. Joseph is a man gifted with the ability to see deeply into the heart of the truth; gifted with a deeper knowing of the truth. Even before he is visited by the angel in his dream (always a sign of deep spiritual knowing) his attitude towards Mary is tender, respectful, loving. He is truly the hero of today's Gospel.
