# A short reflection on today's Gospel John 10:11-18

Today's powerful Gospel clearly and unequivocally instructs us in the way of truth: it is God's love, and only God's love which assures our salvation. Jesus is God's beloved, and, in turn, Jesus is our good shepherd who knows us by name and loves us to the extent of laying down his life for us. The line of love and salvation is clear: God to Jesus to us. The contrast made between the good shepherd and the hired man leads us unerringly to the heart of the truth: the good shepherd will lay down his life for his sheep because he knows them intimately and loves them unconditionally; the hired man, the false shepherd, looks after his own interests and cares little about the welfare of the sheep he is hired to protect.

Jesus, teach us to discern the false shepherds in our midst, and to cling to the pastoral ministry which imitates your mission of healing love, inclusivity and true compassion.

National Year of Prayer for Vocations to the Diocesan Priesthood – As we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday / Vocations Sunday we ask God's blessing on our diocesan seminarians in Rome, Maynooth, and Salamanca, and for all those working in the area of priestly formation. We ask God's blessing on those applying these days to begin their studies in seminary next January. May the Lord inspire many more men to answer His call to serve the people of this diocese as priests.
