

### A short Gospel reflection Matthew 4:12-23

In this Gospel, Jesus begins His public ministry with a simple yet demanding message: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." His words are not spoken from a place of comfort or safety, but in Galilee—an ordinary and even overlooked region. This reminds us that God often enters our lives not in dramatic moments, but in the everyday places where we live and work.

Jesus calls the first disciples while they are busy with their nets. He does not wait for them to be fully prepared or spiritually accomplished. Instead, He invites them as they are, promising to transform their ordinary work into a mission of eternal significance: "I will make you fishers of men." Their immediate response—leaving nets, boats, and even family—challenges us to examine what we cling to that prevents us from fully following Christ.

Finally, Jesus goes about teaching, proclaiming the Kingdom, and healing every disease. The coming of the Kingdom is not just an idea; it is a living reality that brings light, hope, and healing. This passage invites us to repent, to follow, and to trust that when we place our lives in Christ's hands, He can use even our simplest offerings to bring His light to others.

**Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood:** We pray for the men who will be sent out as priests of our diocese "... to preach the Good News..." to God's people in a way that they can understand and that will bring them to a deeper commitment to Jesus as The Word of God.
