# A short reflection on today's Gospel Matthew 28:16-20

Today's Gospel has been acknowledged as a Gospel of revelation and consolation. It reveals Jesus definitively as the true Messiah, the culmination of the promises contained in the Old Testament, invested with 'all authority in heaven and on earth' by his heavenly Father. It reveals, through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, the only meaning to our existence that makes sense: we come from God; we live our lives according to the teachings of Jesus; we return to God. It reveals clearly the fact and power of the Trinity, in the name of which the disciples of Jesus are authorised to baptise all nations: God, the father and creator of all; God, the Son, the pain-bearer for all; God, the Holy Spirit, the giver of knowledge and wisdom for life to all.

Today's Gospel is also a Gospel of consolation, the consolation of the revelation of its truth, and the consolation contained in its final words, the words of Jesus: 'And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'

Jesus, may we always keep your words of consolation and reassurance in our hearts. May we draw comfort from them in times of stress, in times of grief, in times of doubt, knowing that you are closer to us than our own heartbeat.

Jesus, may we always be grateful for your guidance in the way of truth, and may we hold fast to that truth in a world which often, for its own ends, encourages cynicism and doubt.
